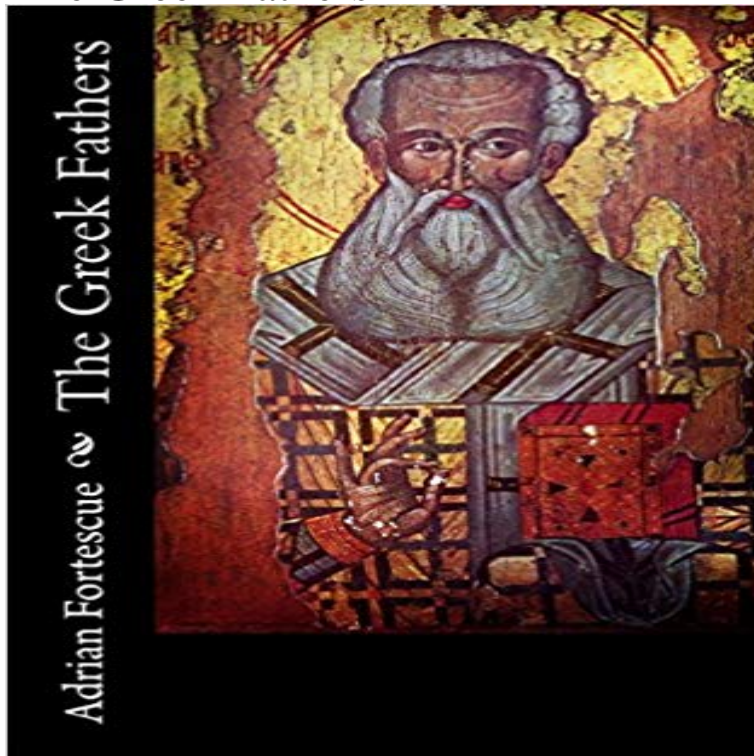


The Greek Fathers
