
## <u>History of the Reformation in the 16th</u> Century (Illustrated)



Jean Henri Merle DAubigne (1794-1872), Swiss minister and historian, is principally renowned for this history of Reformation. Travelling extensively to the libraries containing original archives he carries us back to stand alongside Luther and the other reformers of his time. This is compelling reading, essential for pastors but written with such warmth that all will enjoy its insights. Originally published in French between 1835 and 1853 and subsequently published in five volumes in English 1861-2, this edition has been completely re-typeset for issue as an eBook. It also contains almost 200 illustrations included in a single-volume edition of this work published in 1869.
