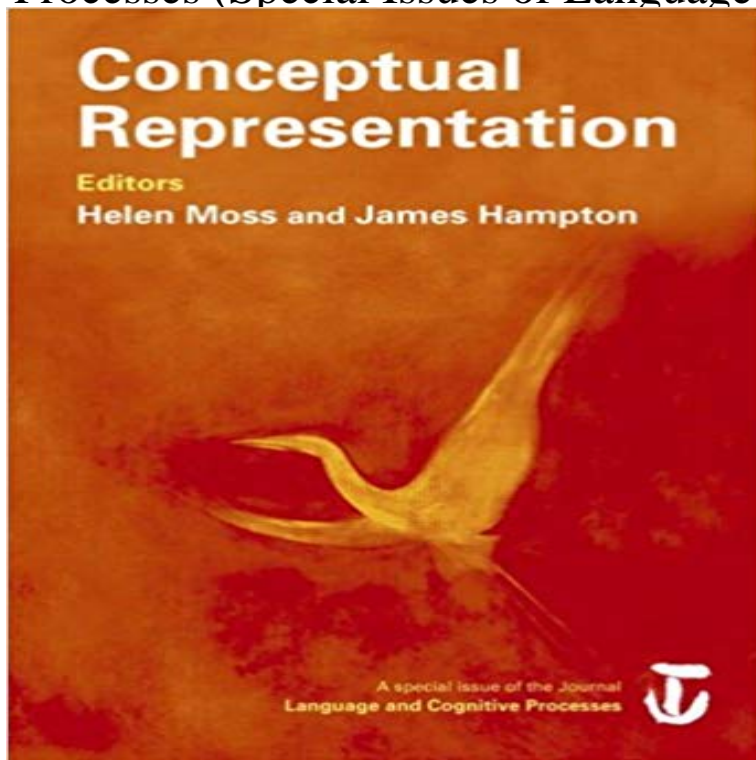


## Conceptual Representation: A Special Issue of Language And Cognitive Processes (Special Issues of Language and Cognitive Processes)
