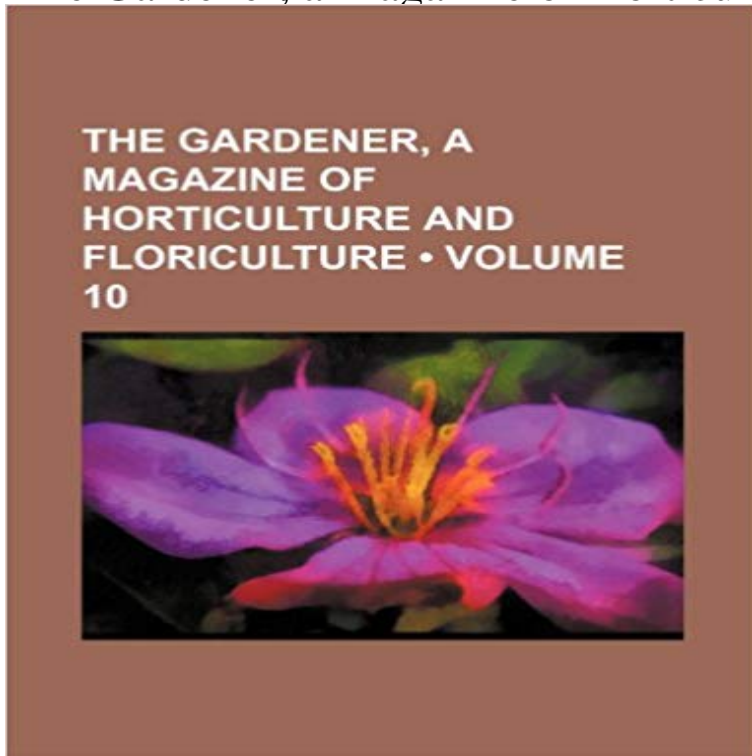

Not illustrated. 1876 Excerpt: ... sun reaches the meridian its rays glance off at a tangent. We get the morning sun, if there is any particular virtue in that, which we never could believe. The western or evening sun is, according to our experience, always the hottest, and both fruit-trees and flowers are earlier on that aspect; and, what we notice constantly, the snow melts on the west borders first. This is curiously exemplified on two herbaceous borders which run north and, south on each side of the centre walk of the kitchen-garden here. Each garden slopes at a gentle angle to the walk; consequently the border on the west side of the walk faces east, and the other west, and on the latter the snow thaws about a day sooner than on the other. This is one of those significant facts which are well worth noting, though no doubt such a thing has been observed and profited by before this. S. HINTS FOR AMATEURS.--JUNE. The thinning of trained trees will now demand much attention, and the greater part of the work may be done without the use of a knife. An active thumb and finger would go over a large proportion of the work in one day. The evils liable to lead one into error are the shortness of labour-power, and the great increase of work which necessitates prompt attention at this season. A moderate amount of attention cannot always be spared, and the trees are then hurried over or neglected altogether; and when winter arrives the wood is badly ripened, and growth is of uneven character. Shoots to fill up empty spaces should be trained wherever there is room without crowding, and care taken to expose the fruit freely to sun. Large spaces vacant among the trees attract the sun so much, that the wall gets so heated that the

branches become scorched; then granting follows. Give good soakings of wat...
