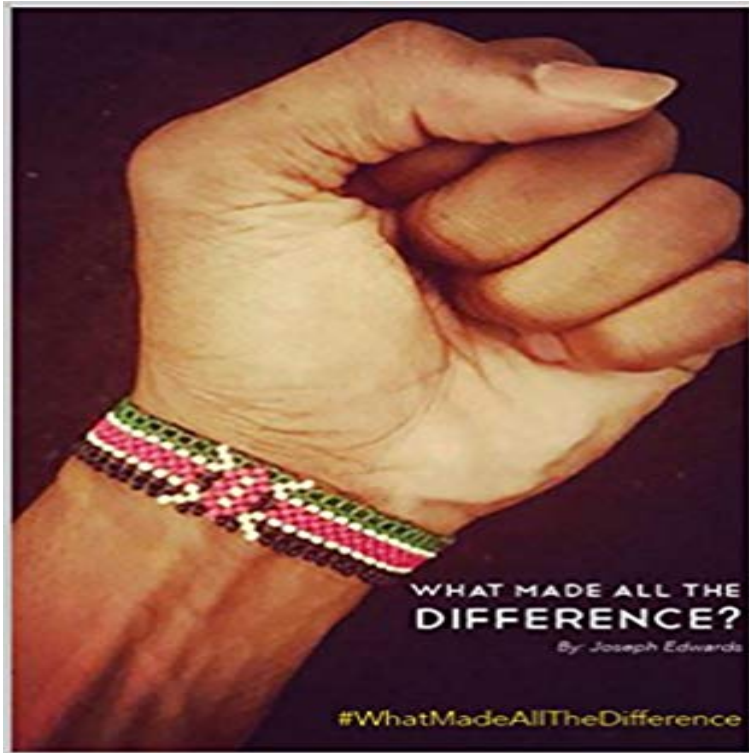


## What made all the difference?
