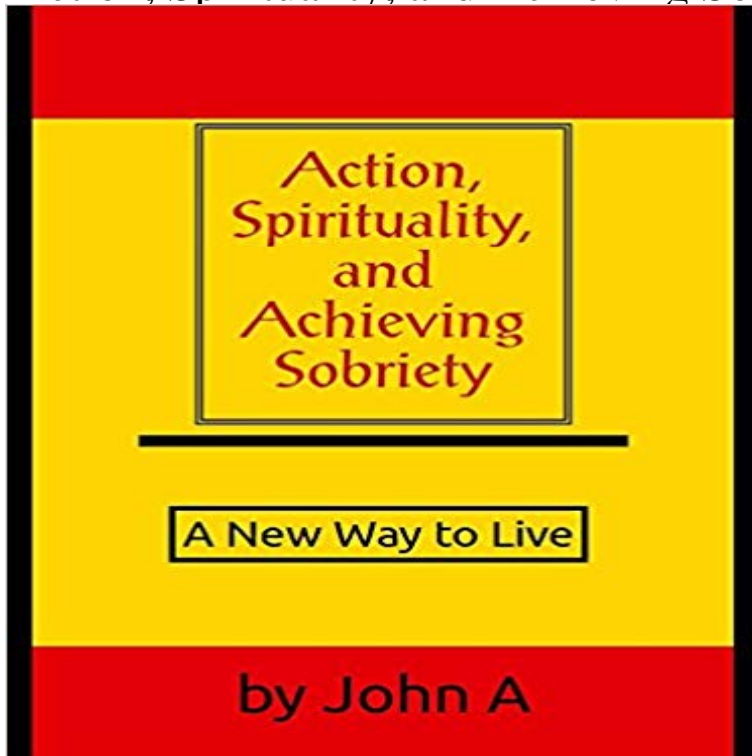


Action, Spirituality, and Achieving Sobriety: A New Way to Live
