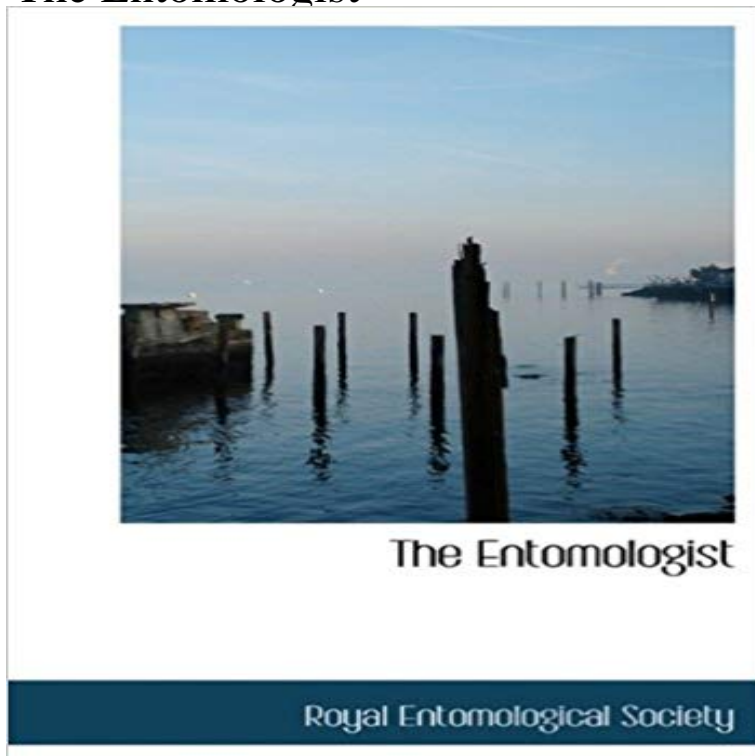


# The Entomologist
